Hello EVC families and Guardians:

I usually would wait to send this to you for the Friday before we would return from Spring Break. However, we have exciting news. EVC will be included in the "Phase 4 Reopening" along with AUSD Elementary schools on April 19th. We will still have a Cohort C. We will allow students to choose in-person or Cohort C as early as the week we come back from Break. And hopefully this will be the last COVID related shift this year in our education offering. The AUSD Board gave Superintendent Lee Alva the direction for EVC to open in Phase 4, five days a week, full days on April 19th. Guidance on middle school situations regarding COVID have drastically changed to allow this. These events all happened this week. We have some details to work out with our District Labor Partners, but this currently is the plan and direction given by the Board. This will effectively be "normal school" with masks, shields, hand hygiene, separate lunches for every grade, and all of the other on-campus mitigation we have worked to put in place. We will return from Spring Break in our current Hybrid Model on April 5th and we will make the shift on Monday April 19th.
